

Activation Instructions – The Journal of Emergency Medicine Online

Please locate your JEM subscription number by logging into your AAEM member's only account at www.aaem.org and clicking on the Publications tab.

Once you have your JEM subscription number, you can start to access the Journal online. To activate your online access please click here: <http://www.jem-journal.com>. If you look on the right side of the page, you will see the activation section.

1. Click on "Activate Online Access".
2. Fill in all appropriate information and hit submit.
3. You will receive an email confirmation of your registration.
4. Go in to claim online access - be sure to choose to access *The Journal of Emergency Medicine*.
5. Make sure to use the section called "Claim Access to a Periodical" not, "Subscribe to a Periodical".
